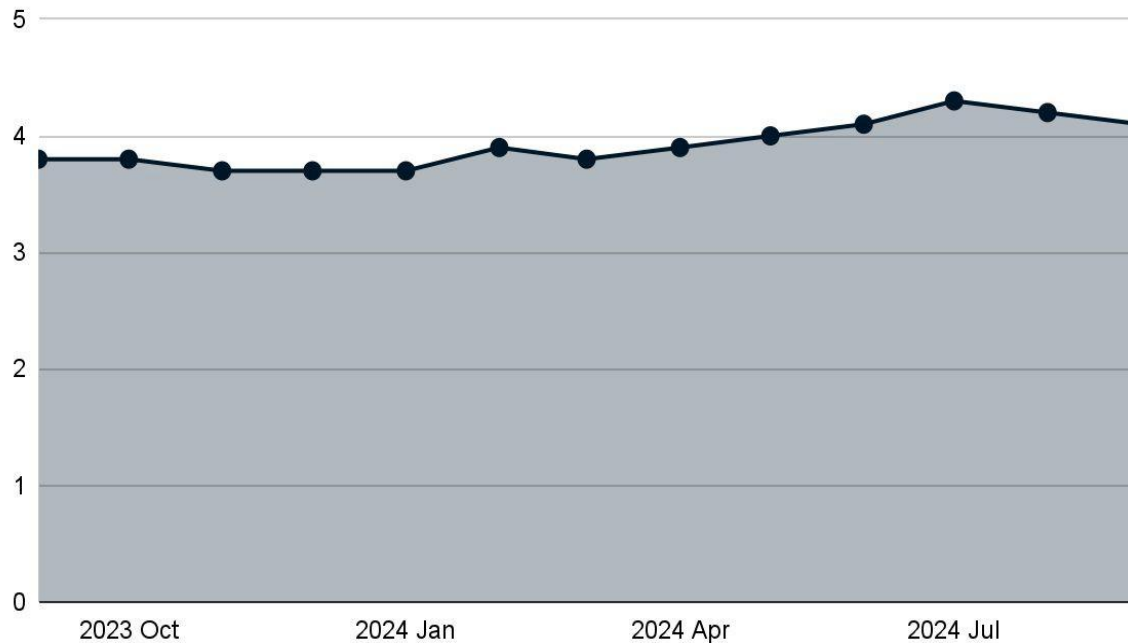

Total nonfarm payroll employment was essentially unchanged in October (+12,000), following an average monthly gain of **194,000** over the prior 12 months. In October, employment continued to trend up in health care and government. Temporary help services lost jobs. Employment declined in manufacturing due to strike activity.

The change in total nonfarm payroll employment for August was revised down by **81,000**, from **+159,000** to **+78,000**, and the change for September was revised down by **31,000**, from **+254,000** to **+223,000**. With these revisions, employment in August and September combined is **112,000** lower than previously reported.
